What To Bring

- 100 or more rounds of target ammunition for your firearm.

- LEAVE YOUR AMMO IN THE CAR! NO AMMO IN THE CLASSROOM!
- A leather or Kydex holster. Safety concerns dictate we limit your selection to Inside or Outside the Waistband strong side belt carry only.
- Cover garment. (Loose shirt or blouse to fit over holster and handgun.)

- Signed and completed course agreement and waiver.
- Documentation of prior training demonstrating successful completion of eight hours.
- State ID or Drivers License.
- Balance of course fee if any please make checks payable to Real Gun Control
- Bottled water.
- A pen
- Three ring binder (1 ½ " thick)
- Notebook

The Full Sixteen

- Same as for the Second Eight but add an extra box of target ammunition
- Need no proof of prior training
